- Recipient will comply with all applicable laws and regulations regarding the transaction(s) for which the safety certificate(s) is used.
- The safety certificate(s) provided allows importation of raw materials for processing for food and feed use only, not for genetic research or planting. Recipient agrees to take reasonable safety control measures to ensure that raw materials imported will not be released into the environment or be used in a way that would cause potential risk to biological diversity, sustainable utilization or human health.
- The certificate(s) may not be used except in accordance with the terms stated herein, and Monsanto reserves the right to withdraw the use of certificate(s) if the Recipient is not in compliance with the terms agreed to in this document.
